### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

### **BUSINESS: Eunice Holland, Transportation Planner**

- Regional Concept Plan (RCP) & Public Involvement Plan (PIP): Mrs. Holland requested that the Committee review the RCP and PIP posted on KRADD's website. The RCP and PIP were changed and updated in the FY 2014. Some of the items included in the documents are transportation issues in the region,

- inventory of rail yards, truck parking, current projects, demographics and traffic generators. Please contact Eunice if you would like a hard copy of the plans.
- The FY 2015 Plan for Committee Activities was presented to the Committee. Four RTC meetings are planned along with an additional meeting for prioritization.
  - FY 2015 Committee By-Laws and Regional Goals & Objectives: The Committee By-Laws and Regional Goals & Objectives were presented to the Committee for their approval. They are the same as FY 2014. Eunice noted that KYTC is required to update the state's Goals & Objectives to align with MAP-21. Once KYTC's Draft Goals & Objectives are approved, changes may occur with the Committee's Goals & Objectives. Changes will be presented for approval at that time. Jim McDannel made the motion to approve the By-Laws and Regional Goals & Objectives as presented. The motion was seconded by Judge Dennis Brooks. Motion carried. The approved documents will be submitted to Central Office and included in the KRADD Public Involvement Plan.

  - August letting for Hacker Branch Bridge in Owsley County.
  - September letting for Owsley County KY 30 bridge at Traveller's Rest and Old Button Bridge on KY 30 in Breathitt County.
  - November letting for Big Creek bridge on KY 1095 in Perry County.
  - December letting for Silver Creek bridge in Beattyville and county bridge on Old Beech Fork in Leatherwood, Perry County.
  - KYTC is currently scheduling a public meeting for the Mountain Parkway to be held in Campton.
- District 11 – Sherri was absent. She sent the following updates:

- Currently we do not have any active construction projects in Leslie County. The most recent completed construction project was guardrail on KY257. Maintenance is busy completing routine maintenance tasks.
- District 12 – Mark was absent. He sent the following updates:
  - The realignment of US 119 in Letcher is continuing with another section to be let in December. A bridge project on KY 343 in Neon is scheduled to be let in September.
  - The rehab project on KY 80 MP 0-5 in Knott County should begin soon. The bridge on KY 3209 has been closed for either repairs or replacement.
  - All asphalt paving in both counties has been completed for this year.
