CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 11:10 AM by Chairman Judge Jim Ward. He welcomed those in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Onzie Sizemore made the motion to approve the Minutes from the May 8th meeting. The motion was seconded by Jim McDannel. Motion carried. The Minutes are on file in the KRADD office.

SPECIAL PRESENTATION

Jeff Hackbart and Valerie Pitts with the UK Kentucky Transportation Center gave a presentation about the Safety Circuit Rider Program. The Safety Circuit Rider program is funded through a grant from the Federal Highway Administration in coordination with

the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet. It operates from the technology Transfer Program (T2) of the Kentucky Transportation Center with the University of Kentucky. The program is designed to provide safety-related information, training, and support to agencies responsible for local roadway safety. Collision data is used to locate high crash sites along roadways and to assist communities in finding low-cost safety improvements. Examples of these improvements are removal of fixed objects such as trees, brush, stumps, etc. and installation of signage. This technical advice is free of charge.

BUSINESS: Eunice Holland, Transportation Planner

- Regional Concept Plan (RCP) & Public Involvement Plan (PIP): Mrs. Holland requested that the Committee review the RCP and PIP posted on KRADD's website. The RCP and PIP were changed and updated in the FY 2013. Some of the items included in the documents are transportation issues in the region, inventory of rail yards, truck parking, current projects, demographics and traffic generators. Please contact Eunice if you would like a hard copy of the plans.
- The FY 2014 Plan for Committee Activities was presented to the Committee. Four RTC meetings are planned along with a local meeting to discuss projects in the spring of 2014.
- FY 2014 Committee By-Laws and Regional Goals & Objectives: The Committee By-Laws and Regional Goals & Objectives were presented to the Committee for their approval. The By-Laws are the same as FY 2013. Safety/Security was changed to System Reliability in the Regional Goals & Objectives. Eunice noted that KYTC is required to update the state's Goals & Objectives to align with MAP-21, which was approved in October 2012. Once KYTC's Draft Goals & Objectives are approved, changes may occur with the Committee's Goals & Objectives. Changes will be presented for approval at that time. Jim McDannel made the motion to approve the By-Laws and Regional Goals & Objectives as presented. The motion was seconded by Mayor Nan Gorman. Motion carried. The approved documents will be submitted to Central Office and included in the KRADD Public Involvement Plan.
- New Project: Eunice presented one project to be added to the Unscheduled Needs List (UNL) and provided a map to the Committee.
 - Perry County KY 80 - 10 097 D0080 3.00 – Improve intersection at Justice Drive on KY 80 in HazardThe project is part of the KY 80 Traffic Study completed in January 2012. Judge Jim Ward made the motion to approve the project. Jim McDannel seconded the motion. Motion passed.
