CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 11:05 AM by Chairman Judge Jim Ward. He welcomed those in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Judge Dennis Brooks made the motion to approve the Minutes from the May 9th meeting. The motion was seconded by Roger Friley. Motion carried. The Minutes are on file in the KRADD office.

BUSINESS: Eunice Holland, Transportation Planner

- FY 2013 Committee By-Laws and Regional Goals & Objectives: The Committee By-Laws and Regional Goals & Objectives were presented to the Committee for their approval. The By-Laws are the same as FY 2012. Regionalism and Public Involvement was added to the Regional Goals & Objectives. Judge Dennis Brooks made the motion to approve the By-Laws and Regional Goals & Objectives as presented. The motion was seconded by Roger Friley. Motion carried. The approved documents will be submitted to Central Office and included in the KRADD Public Involvement Plan.
- Regional Concept Plan (RCP) & Public Involvement Plan (PIP): Mrs. Holland requested that the Committee review the RCP and PIP posted on KRADD's website. The RCP and PIP were changed and updated in the FY 2012. Some of

- the items included in the documents are transportation issues in the region, inventory of rail yards, truck parking, current projects, demographics and traffic generators. Please contact Eunice if you would like a hard copy of the plans.
- LPA Project Guide Training Dates: The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Office of Local Programs has released the new Local Public Agency (LPA) Project Guide. LPA Workshops have been scheduled throughout the state. The closest one to the KRADD Region will be held at Natural Bridge State Resort Park on February 12, 2013. This is a six hour course and is approved for DLG County Officials Incentive Program hours. There is no fee and you can register at www.kyt2.com.
 - Local Project Review Meetings: As part of the ADD's Planning Program, Eunice along with the Highway District Office Planning Engineer is required to meet with each of the County Judge Executives to discuss the Highway Plan, District Transportation Plan and projects on our UNL. Mrs. Holland and the Districts have met with Owsley, Lee, Perry, Wolfe and Letcher. Leslie County has been scheduled.
 - FY2012-FY2018 Highway Plan: A copy of the highway plan was provided to those present. A listing of the newly added projects and a map of all the projects was also provided. Eunice reviewed those projects added to the Highway Plan in 2012.

PROJECT UPDATES & CONCERNS:

KYTC Highway District 10: Jason Blackburn

- Breathitt – KY 3231 – started ROW
- Breathitt – Quicksand bridge replacement – finished ROW
- Breathitt – KY 15 pave and open next year
- Breathitt – KY 1098 – Southfork resurfacing will let in August
- Owsley – KY 30 – Bridge replacement, starting ROW
- Owsley – KY 28 - Started design on traffic light installation at High School
- Perry – KY 15 – Select Consultant by the end of August
- Wolfe – Mountain Parkway – 55 Mph curve added to Highway Plan
- KY 15 from KY 28 in Perry County to Campton - Programming Study with QK4 will be finished before next budget

KYTC Highway District 11: Sherri Chappell

- Leslie County – KY 699 – bridge replacement will let in August
- Leslie County – KY 3224 Hal Rogers approach at Thousandsticks VFD – finishing designs in house, letting in 2013
- Leslie County – KY 1850 – Middlefork bridge replacement – handling in-house

KYTC Highway District 12: Willard Cuzzort

- Knott County – KY 1231 – December letting
- Knott County – KY 550 - curve improvement

- Letcher County – KY 343 two bridge replacements at Fleming-Neon – letting in November
- Letcher County – US 119 from Harlan C/L to foot of Pine Mountain – letting in September - \$21 million – working with Black Mountain Resources for ROW

PUBLIC COMMENT

Jim McDannel expressed his concern for two dangerous intersections in Letcher County. Both are on KY 15 at the intersection with KY 3401 and at the Parkway Inn Motel. Willard Cuzzort from District 12 assured Jim that he and Eunice Holland will look at the intersections and add them to the UNL. Mayor Nan Gorman asked about the status of Glomawr Bridge (KY 451) in Perry County. Jason Blackburn from District 10 said that the design is finished and that the state is awaiting cooperation with CSX Railroad Corporation.
