CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 11:10 AM by Chairman Judge Jim Ward. He welcomed those in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Jim McDannel made the motion to approve the Minutes from the August 21st and November 13th meetings. The motion was seconded by Onzie Sizemore. Motion carried. The Minutes are on file in the KRADD office.

SPECIAL PRESENTATION

Tom Nein and Bill Waller with Contech Engineered Solutions gave a presentation to the Committee. Contech Engineered Solutions' headquarters are in West Chester, Ohio. Contech offers engineering design and support for bridge, drainage, earth stabilization, and stormwater solutions.

BUSINESS: Eunice Holland, Transportation Planner

- Socioeconomic Data Maps – Maps representing four populations in the KRADD region are included in the Public Involvement Plan. Eunice presented the maps for Age Over 60, Minority, Poverty Status and Disability Age 16 to 64. The data will be analyzed for future Environmental Justice Reviews for the KYTC.
- Recommended Highway Plan – A copy of projects in the Recommended Highway Plan were given to committee members. Also, a listing of newly added projects and a map were presented. The Governor released the Recommended Highway Plan to legislatures in January. Lawmakers may and will change the plan. The final Highway Plan is expected to be released in May.

PROJECT UPDATES & CONCERNS:

KYTC Highway District 10:

Jason Blackburn was absent, but provided an update on the KY 15 project in Perry County. KY 15 from Morton Blvd. to Bonnyman is currently in the Right of Way process. Strand and Associates are handling the project.

KYTC Highway District 11:

Sherri Chappell provided updates for Leslie County:

- Slide repairs on KY 1850
- Safety improvements on a section of Hal Rogers Parkway completed

KYTC Highway District 12:

Mark Westfall provided updates:

- Letcher County – US 119 project from Whitesburg to Jenkins is new to the District and the Highway Plan. After being on the Highway Plan since the 90s, the tunnel bore was taken out.
