CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 11:00 AM by Chairman Judge Jim Ward. He welcomed those in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Judge Dennis Brooks made the motion to approve the Minutes from the November 7th meeting. The motion was seconded by Roger Milligan. Motion carried. The Minutes are on file in the KRADD office.

GUEST SPEAKER

Charlie Spalding, KYTC Division of Planning, talked about the Long Range Plan Update. The Long Range Plan is updated every 6 years. In determining the transportation needs for all areas of Kentucky over the next two decades, the updated plan will consider changes in communities, freight movement, financial resources, economic development, rural and urban transportation, the environment and other transportation issues that are impacting the public. The Cabinet is seeking input with a survey titled “Your Turn”. The survey will run from January 9th to February 25th.

Charlie showed a map with the responses by county as of February 11th. Those present received a survey to complete.

BUSINESS: Eunice Holland, Transportation Planner

- Incident Management Public Meeting: Highway District 10 will be hosting a meeting for disaster and emergency services personnel, elected officials and other stakeholders in their 10 counties (Breathitt, Lee, Owsley, Perry and Wolfe in the KRADD Region). The meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 5 at 10 a.m. at the Kentucky River Area Development District in Hazard. This will be an informative meeting where various aspects of the KYTC Incident Management Program will be discussed.
- New Projects: Eunice described the two new projects to be added to the Unscheduled Needs List (UNL) and provided a map of each to the Committee.
 - Perry County KY 15 - 10 097 D0015 2.00 – Improve railroad crossing and approaches at 3 locations in South Perry.
 - Perry County KY 80 – 10 097 D0080 1.00 – Replace existing drainage structure and realign approaches on a .2 mile section of KY 80 near the Leslie/Perry County Line.

Judge Ronnie DeBord made the motion to approve the two projects. Roger Milligan seconded the motion. Motion passed.

- 2013 Prioritization: An updated schedule was presented to the Committee. Prioritization began in January. County ranking sheets were mailed to Judges, Mayors and Magistrates. Meetings with County Judge Executives and Highway Districts to discuss local rankings and obtain local priorities will begin February 18th and be completed by March 29th. County rankings will be presented to the RTC during regional prioritization. All projects on the UNL will be prioritized this cycle at the local level. The top 6 projects (48 total) from each county will be ranked by the Regional Transportation Committee. Ranking sheets by cost tier will be mailed to each RTC Member on April 1st. The projects will be scored and a top 10 ranking for each cost tier and an overall top 10 will be presented to the Committee on May 8th for approval.
- Highway District Updates: Highway District 10, 11, and 12 are having a regional meeting at Buckhorn Lodge today and were unable to attend. Sherri Chappell from D11 wanted to inform the committee that a guardrail project on KY 1482 in Leslie County has begun. Also, they all remind the committee to complete the LRP Survey.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Jim McDannel asked about the intersection of KY 3402 and KY 15 in Letcher County. Eunice informed him that Mark Westfall from Highway District 12 was looking into that intersection as a possible project.

ADJOURNMENT

Judge Dennis Brooks made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Judge Ronnie DeBord seconded the motion. Motion passed. The meeting was adjourned for lunch at 11:20 AM. The next meeting will be Wednesday, May 8, 2013 for Regional Prioritization.
