CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 12:42 PM by Vice-Chairman Judge Dennis Brooks. He welcomed those in attendance.

GUEST SPEAKER:

Charlie Spalding with KYTC Division of Planning reviewed the results of the statewide Rural Consultation Survey. Every five years KYTC is required by FHWA to poll the

mayors and judge-executives as to their awareness of the Regional Transportation Program. This year the KYTC will also include the Regional Transportation Committee members in that process. The survey was completed in December.

BUSINESS: Jason Blackburn, KYTC Highway District 10

A study was performed to identify potential improvements at 50 intersections within KYTC District 10. The list of intersections, along with detailed crash information, was evaluated and proposed safety improvements for each of the intersections were developed. Projects with a total cost estimate less than \$500,000 may be selected for implementation using Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds. Projects exceeding the HSIP amount will require a Project Identification Form (PIF). 32 of the 50 intersections were in the 5 KRADD counties within District 10. 5 of those intersections exceed the HSIP limit. Therefore, 4 new projects will be added to the Unscheduled Needs List (UNL) and 1 existing project will be updated.
