CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 12:20 PM by Transportation Planner Eunice Holland. She welcomed those in attendance. Eunice announced that since the officers were unable to attend, the Committee will not be voting on any items.

GUEST SPEAKER:

Joseph Troy Hearn is the Bicycle and pedestrian program coordinator with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (4years). He is married with 3 kids and one grandchild. He graduated from the University of Kentucky with a major in Business/Marketing & Minor in History. Troy has worked in the Bicycle Industry for over 25 years and is a very active pedestrian and bicyclist for the past 35 years. Mr. Hearn discussed the steps to develop a Pedestrian and Bicycle Plan.

BUSINESS: Eunice Holland, Transportation Planner

- The **FY 2017 Committee Meeting Schedule** was presented.
- The **Hazard Mitigation Plan** is updated every 5 years. KRADD is currently meeting with County Emergency Managers to update maps. Public hearings will be scheduled in each of the 8 counties in June. The hearings will be held in conjunction with the Fiscal Court Meetings. We would like as much input as possible. If you know of any new hazards on county roads, please notify Annette Napier (Annette@kradd.org).
- The Kentucky Office of Highway Safety began the **Yellow Dot Program** this year. This program alerts first responders at crash scenes of critical medical information that could save a life. The Yellow Dot decal is placed in the lower-left corner on the driver-side rear window. A Yellow Dot personal information folder is placed into the glove compartment of the vehicle. Eunice has distributed over 1,000 folders to the Senior Citizens Centers and LKLP Outreach Centers.
