Jim McDannel made the motion to approve the new projects. Judge Dennis Brooks seconded the motion. Motion passed.

- 2015 Regional Prioritization: Local meetings were held January and February with County Judge Executives. Active UNL Projects were reviewed and ranked. As we have done in the past few cycles, the top 5 projects from each county (total of 40) will be ranked by the RTC. The listing and maps have been provided to the committee. Six Year Plan SP projects, pavement and bridge projects are also available for ranking this cycle. The complete listing was provided to the ADDs on May 1st. With the time constraint and since those projects were not ranked locally, the RTC will be only ranking the UNL projects. The committee can rank those projects and add those into the listing if they may choose. The Highway Districts will be ranking the SYP, pavement and bridge projects along with UNL projects in their ranking process. I have provided the committee with that listing in the packet. KYTC Planning has developed a scoring process. A sheet explaining the scoring criteria is included in your packet. The technical score

along with the local rank is provided for each of the 40 projects. After talking with the Highway Districts and Chairman Judge Jim Ward, the 40 UNL projects are ranked by highest technical score for each county, second highest score for each county, third highest score for each county, and so on. Chairman Judge Jim Ward stated that this preliminary ranking provides the regional/local input along with utilizing the technical score. Chairman Judge Jim Ward opened the floor for discussion.

With no further discussion, Judge JL Smith made the motion to approve the rankings as presented. Jack Campbell seconded the motion. Motion passed. The list of regional rankings is attached to this document.

The regional rankings will be recommended to the KRADD Board of Directors on May 27th for their approval. After the rankings are approved, they will be submitted to the Highway District Office and KYTC Division of Planning. Rankings will also be updated in the online PIF application.
