CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 11:05 AM by Chairman Judge Jim Ward. He welcomed those in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Jim McDannel made the motion to approve the Minutes from the February 8th meeting. The motion was seconded by Mayor Rose Wolfe. Motion carried. The Minutes are on file in the KRADD office.

GUEST SPEAKERS:

- Michael Woods, Public Transportation Director, LKLP Community Action Council, Inc. discussed current programs and grants the organization applied for

this fiscal year. LKLP has a four county operating area: Letcher, Knott, Leslie and Perry. Morgan and Harlan are included in their coordination efforts. LKLP covers nearly 60 counties in the Commonwealth for Medicaid Broker services. Grants applied for this year include cutaway buses, mini vans, camera/video equipment, and generators.

- Taylor Davis, EIT and John Dobson, PIO with Highway District 11 in Manchester gave a report on the public meeting held in Leslie County. The meeting was held May 3, 2012 at the Big Creek Mission in Leslie County regarding a new connector from Hal Rovers Parkway to US 421/KY 80 or KY 1482. The KYTC continues to move forward with design of this roadway improvement project in the Bear Branch community. Three final alternatives were presented to over 100 residents in attendance. KYTC District 11 will continue to collect public comments for 15 days after the meeting. The comments will be compiled and tabulated to determine the public's preferred alternative. The KYTC Project Development Team will then meet to review all the comments and make a final selection for the project.

BUSINESS: Eunice Holland, Transportation Planner

- Census Maps: Maps indicating 2010 Census Data are part of the Public Involvement Plan each ADD develops. Eunice reviewed the data represented on the maps presented to those present.
- FY 2012 Schedule: Mrs. Holland provided the FY 2013 Committee meeting schedule.

PROJECT UPDATES & CONCERNS:

KYTC Highway District 10: Jason Blackburn (Mr. Blackburn was not in attendance, but met with Eunice earlier in the week to go over project updates for the meeting.)

- Breathitt – KY 3231 – started ROW and Utilities, anticipated letting June 2013
- Lee – KY 11 – Reconstruct from KY 30 in Booneville to KY 587, finalizing design, ROW expected next year
- Owsley – KY 30 – Bridge replacement, starting ROW and Utilities
- Perry – KY 80 – Address safety issues and deteriorating pavement from KY 15 to KY 476, July 2012 letting
- Wolfe – KY 191 – Replace bridge in Hazel Green, November 2012 letting
- Wolfe – KY 205 – Starting ROW

KYTC Highway District 11: Taylor Davis

- Leslie County – KY 699 – bridge replacement will let in August
- Leslie County – KY 3224 Hal Rogers approach at Thousandsticks VFD – finishing designs in house, letting in 2013

KYTC Highway District 12: Willard Cuzzort

- Knott County – Steer Fork Road bridge replacement off of KY 7 – letting in June
- Letcher County – KY 343 two bridge replacements at Fleming-Neon – letting in December

- Letcher County – US 119 from Harlan C/L to foot of Pine Mountain – letting in July - \$21 million

PUBLIC COMMENT

Judge Jim Ward asked Willard Cuzzort from Highway District 12 the status of the county bridges to be replaced in Letcher County. Willard mentioned 4 bridges that are on the schedule: Watts Drive, Camden Road, Isom Racetrack and Paces Branch. All bridges will be funded with federal dollars and are in the designing phase.
