CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 11:10 AM by Chairman Judge Jim Ward. He welcomed those in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Judge Dennis Brooks made the motion to approve the Minutes from the August 8th meeting. The motion was seconded by Roger Friley. Motion carried. The Minutes are on file in the KRADD office.

BUSINESS: Eunice Holland, Transportation Planner

- Multimodal Contacts: The ADD maintains a contact list and email list-serve for those who have interest in the region. This list includes contact information for representatives of aviation, railroads, and trails for hiking, biking, horse and ATV. Eunice presented the map and listing to the Committee for review. No changes were needed.

- **Local Planning Units:** The ADD maintains an inventory of land use plans, planning commissions and/or zoning ordinances. A survey was completed for each county in 2009. There are four local planning units in the KRADD region. Two of those are active and two are inactive. Eunice presented a map of the planning units with contact information to the Committee. Roger Friley stated that Arch Sebastian is the current Chairman of the Jackson Planning and Zoning Commission. Mayor Gorman verified that Randy Hackney is the contact for the Hazard Planning and Zoning Commission.
- **New Projects:** A listing of 10 new projects to be added to the Unscheduled Needs List (UNL) was presented to the Committee. Eunice reviewed each project.
- **Inactive Projects:** 9 UNL projects were presented and reviewed. These projects were identified at the local meetings with the Judge Executives and Highway Districts. The projects need to be moved to inactive status for various reasons. Onzie Sizemore made the motion to approve the new projects and inactive projects as presented. Judge Dennis Brooks seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- **2013 Prioritization Process:** A schedule was presented to the Committee. Prioritization will begin in January with meetings with County Judge Executives and Highway Districts to obtain local priorities. Local priorities will be completed by March 29th and presented to the RTC during regional prioritization. All projects on the UNL will be prioritized this cycle. Projects will be reviewed at the February 13th RTC meeting. The RTC will meet on May 8th to rank projects by cost tier and overall. The top 10 rankings for each cost tier and an overall top 10 will be submitted to the Highway District Offices and Central Office by July 15, 2013.

PROJECT UPDATES & CONCERNS:

KYTC Highway District 10:

Aric Skaggs was announced as the Branch Manager of Project Development.

Jason Blackburn (not in attendance, but provided updates via email):

- Breathitt County – Marie Roberts and Old Buck bridges are in design
- Breathitt County – letting Quicksand Bridge in December
- Lee County – letting county bridge in February
- Lee/Owsley County – working on plans for KY 11
- Owsley County – finish design on KY 30
- Perry County – moving along with design on KY 15 and all 5 bridge replacements
- Wolfe County – Judy Construction was awarded the Hazel Green bridge project

KYTC Highway District 11:

Sherri Chappell was announced as the Acting Chief District Engineer for District 11.

Sherri Chappell:

- Leslie County – KY 699 – bridge replacement
- Leslie County – Asphalt resurfacing completed on sections of KY 406, KY 2009, and KY 3427.
- Leslie County – KY 1482 – guardrail project

- Leslie County – KY 1850 – low water bridge replaced with culvert – doubled the capacity

KYTC Highway District 12:

Mark Westfall:

- Letcher County – KY 343 two bridge replacements at Fleming-Neon – letting in April
- Letcher County – US 119 from Harlan C/L to foot of Pine Mountain - \$21 million – working with Black Mountain Resources for ROW
- Letcher County – US 119 – all sections are funded – 3rd section will be let in December 2013

PUBLIC COMMENT

Jim McDannel requested that Eunice and Highway District 12 look at the intersection of KY 3402 and KY 15 in Letcher County. The intersection is in a curve and sight distance is very poor. Todd DePriest asked Mark Westfall for contact information regarding the KY 805 project in Letcher County. Onzie Sizemore asked Sherri Chappell about the Hal Rogers Parkway entrance at Big Creek in Leslie County. Sherri stated that there was a public meeting held May 3rd. The project is awaiting additional funding to move past design.

Onzie Sizemore made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Mayor G.C. Kincer seconded the motion. The next meeting will be Wednesday, February 13, 2013. The meeting was adjourned at 11:35 AM.
