CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 11:10 AM by Chairman Judge Jim Ward. He welcomed those in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mayor Scott Cornett made the motion to approve the Minutes from the May 11th meeting. The motion was seconded by Judge Dennis Brooks. Motion carried. The Minutes are on file in the KRADD office.

BUSINESS: Eunice Holland, Transportation Planner

- **FY 2012 Committee Schedule:** Meetings are held each quarter. The meetings dates for FY2012 are: August 10th, November 9th, February 8th, and May 9th.
- **FY 2012 Committee By-Laws:** Changes to the By-Laws for FY 2012 are:
 - Article III Section 2 – KYTC Highway District Staff will no longer be voting members of the committee. They will serve as technical advisors.

- Article III Section 8 – The designated representative for each County Judge Executive and Mayor on the KRADD Board of Directors will be the designated representative for the Committee.
- Article IV Section 1 – Meeting day was changed to Wednesday. Last fiscal year we met on Thursdays.
- **FY 2012 Committee Goals & Objectives:** No changes were made to the Goals & Objectives. Judge Dennis Brooks made the motion to approve the FY 2012 By-Laws and Goals & Objectives as presented. Judge Jim Ward seconded the motion. Motion passed.

SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS

- **District Improvement Plan, Jason Blackburn, KYTC/HDO 10**
 - Throughout the state each Highway District Office has been tasked with developing a District Transportation Improvement Plan. Consultants have been hired to help develop the plan.
 - The Districts have had their first team meeting. HDO personnel from all branches, ADD Transportation Planners, and consultants were present. An online program was used to map current projects on the UPL and Highway Plan projects. Data such as: crashes, landslides, rockfalls, narrow lanes, curves, narrow shoulders, elevation, congestion, and traffic flow were mapped. Those sections with high risk factors that did not have a UPL or Highway Plan project were added to a ‘Gaps’ list.
 - The second meeting will be held in August with the teams. The ‘Gaps’ listing along with current UPL projects will then be ranked. A top 30 ranking is requested to include in the Transportation Plan.
 - The finished plan will be available for review. Eunice will provide a copy to the Committee and the HDO Planners will present their plan at a future meeting. This plan will be updated every 2 years or as needed.
 - Eunice presented the Committee with a list of projects identified with this process (attached). There are 16 new projects to add to the UPL and 2 projects to move to inactive status. The 2 projects were very large projects and Jason and Eunice thought is best to split the projects into smaller ones. Those break-out projects are included in the 16. Judge Dennis Brooks made the motion to approve the 16 new projects and move the 2 Breathitt County projects to inactive. Judge Jimmy Sizemore’s proxy Onzie Sizemore seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- **Local Roads Spatial Application, John Chester, KRADD GIS/GPS Technician**
 - KYTC has developed a new IMS specifically for local roads with the ADD local road data collection program and the local road owners in mind.
 - Although the site is not fully developed it is functional enough for you to start using. We feel this will be a very useful tool for KRADD and the local agencies.

- John went through the application and instructed the committee on how to use all the tools available.
- The link will be on KRADD's website.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Ben Hale from the Department of Local Government wanted to inform the committee of two conferences being held in the state. The DLG Local Issues Conference will be held next week August 17-19th at the Galt House in Louisville. Governor Beshear is the co-chair of the ARC. Kentucky will be hosting the Annual ARC Conference this year. The Conference is September 7-9 in Prestonsburg. Sessions will be held at the MAC and Jenny Wiley State Park. Judge Jim Ward encouraged all County Judge Executives and Mayors to attend.

The next meeting will be Wednesday, November 9, 2011. Judge Dennis Brooks made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Jim McDannel seconded the motion. Motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 11:37 PM
