CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation and Safety Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 1:06 PM by Transportation Planner Eunice Holland. She welcomed those in attendance.

SPECIAL PRESENTATION

KRADD Transportation Planner gave a brief presentation highlighting “Transportation Data on The Web.” She provided a handout including URLs and screenshots of how to obtain data on the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet and KRADD websites.

NEW BUSINESS

- ❖ FY 2010 Committee Meetings – Mrs. Holland noted that a listing of scheduled meetings for FY 2010 is included in the handouts. Additional meetings may be scheduled as needed.
- ❖ 2008 Highway Plan – Copies of the recently released 2008 Highway Plan including projects added during the Special Session this summer was distributed to those present. The handout included the Narrative, project listing for KRADD Counties, and District 10, 11, and 12 Maps.
- ❖ Committee Goals & Objectives and Committee By-Laws – Eunice requested the Committee to review FY 2009 documents and provided any suggested changes to her between now and the October meeting. Both documents will be approved for FY 2010 at the October 15th meeting.
- ❖ FY 2010 Annual Work Plan – Mrs. Holland briefly discussed new activities for FY 2010 to be included in the Regional Concept Plan:
 - Bike/Ped/Greenway Contact List – Listing local coordinators and committee members in the region. Due November.
 - Local Planning Units – Collecting additional data for Planning Units in each county. Due January.
 - List of Rail Yards – Provide data on all rail yards in the region. Due April.
 - Multimodal Freight Users Inventory – Collect data regarding manufacturers with more than 100 employees in the region. Due April.

PROJECT UPDATES

- ❖ District 10 – Corbett Caudill mentioned the following projects:
 - Breathitt – There will be a public meeting in the fall regarding Rockfall Mitigation on Lakeside Drive; Next section of KY 15 to be let for construction in September.
 - Lee – Design will start on the KY 52 project to widen and add sidewalks.
 - Owsley – Replace Bridge and Approaches on KY 30 over Little Sturgeon Creek will be let to design in the fall; \$500,000 of Federal monies has been funded to do the NEPA requirements for a 6 miles section of KY 30.
 - Perry – KY 80 Bridge Replacement at AB Combs/84 Lumber will begin design soon; KY 7 Relocation from Jeff to Viper is approximately 10 months away from completion; Design for Exit 56 (median barrier, replace culvert with a bridge, and new lighting) is complete waiting on construction monies.

- Wolfe - Reconstruct KY 205 from Breathitt to Mountain Parkway is in design; Spot improvements to KY 191 at Hazel Green will begin design in the fall.
- ❖ District 11 - Chris Harris briefly discussed the projects for Leslie County:
 - KY 699 Construct new high water bridge is under construction.
 - Currently fixing US 421 at the 13 mile marker where a culvert failed and washed the road away.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mrs. Holland recognized the attendance of Charlie Spalding from the Division of Planning in Frankfort.
