The KRADD Regional Transportation and Safety Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 1:04 PM by Secretary Mayor Charles Dixon. He welcomed those in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Roger Milligan made the motion to approve the Minutes from the June 17th meeting. The motion was seconded by Jack Burkich. Motion carried. The Minutes are on file in the KRADD office.

BUSINESS

- Mayor Dixon presented the FY 2011 Committee Schedule, By-Laws, and Goals & Objectives. The committee reviewed the documents and decided that no changes were needed. Roger Milligan made the motion to approve the FY 2011 Committee Schedule, By-Laws and Goals & Objectives as presented. Roger Friley seconded the motion. Motion carried. Approved documents will be submitted to the Cabinet.
- Eunice noted that attendance has been low for the Regional Transportation & Safety Planning Committee and Water Management Council. Jennifer McIntosh, KRADD Community Resources Planner, and Mike Miller, KRADD Executive Director suggested having joint meetings beginning February 2011. Meetings will begin at approximately 11am with the Transportation Committee; lunch will be provided then the Water Council will meet. The meeting will last no longer than 90 minutes. The two committees will still be kept separate, but will share members. This may improve our attendance and give us the opportunity to provide lunch to the members.

- Lakeside Drive in Breathitt County - Bond Money in 2011
- October letting - Perry County - Exit 56 and Rockfall Mitigation on KY 7
- KY 205 in Wolfe County public meeting set for September 9th and will be held in Breathitt County at Hampton United Church in Peggs Fork.

Joseph Mosley - District 11 (Leslie County)

- Industrial Park letting in October
- 11-1078 - US 421 bridge replacement Phase I design in the fall
- 11-5010 - US 421 slide repair Stinnett Hill Phase I design in the fall
- 11-8516 - Hal Rogers Parkway - Access road near Clay County line - Design will take approximately 18-24 months - project does involve one bridge
- 11-8519 - KY 699 bridge replacement ROW mid 2011

Willard Cuzzort - District 12 (Knott and Letcher Counties)

- Curb improvement at Knott County Central will be finished in September
- Widening and replacing 2 bridges on KY 15 and KY 15X in Whitesburg will be finished in September
- US 119 Pine Mountain section near Harlan County line will be completed in the Spring of 2011.
- Bridge construction on KY 1098 near Decoy in Knott County was let July 31st
- Bridge construction on Craft Colly Road in Letcher County was let July 31st

- Intersection of KY 15 and KY 160 near Carr Creek Lake in Knott County will be let for construction in October - the project will improve sight distance and improve safety
