CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 11:05 AM by Chairman Judge Jim Ward. He welcomed those in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Judge Dennis Brooks made the motion to approve the Minutes from the August 10th meeting. The motion was seconded by Mayor Rose Wolfe. Motion carried. The Minutes are on file in the KRADD office.

SPECIAL PRESENTATION

Charlie Spalding from KYTC Central Office talked about the timeline of a project.

- Suggested projects can come from: ADD Transportation Committees, ADD Planner, Planning Studies, Public Citizens, KYTC, Local Officials, Tourism, Highway District Offices, or Economic Development.

- Projects are funneled through the ADD, MPO and HDO offices where the Transportation Planners research the project from the Division of Planning resources and data.
- Photographs are taken and site specific maps are prepared to locate the project.
- A PIF is prepared cooperatively by the HDO, ADD, and MPO Planners and reviewed by the Transportation Committee for concurrence and public input.
- The PIF is sent to the Division of Planning for numbering and review.
- The reviewed PIF receives a control number and is entered into the online PIF Application and added to the Unscheduled Projects List (UPL).
- Projects stay on the UPL until they are fully scheduled in the Highway Plan or are determined to no longer be necessary and the ADD/MPO/HDO requests that they be purged from the database.
- Projects on the UPL are prioritized by the local officials, ADD/MPO Transportation Committees, and the Highway District Offices every two years.
- Projects selected from the UPL to be scheduled for funding are included in the Highway Plan.
- The Recommended Highway Plan is submitted to the Legislature for review and changes. The Enacted Highway Plan then is released by KYTC around June of even number years.
- IF a project gets funded and if all goes according to schedule, here is the basic timeline: Year 0: Long Range Planning, Year 1: Highway Plan, Year 2-3: Project Planning, Year 4-5: Preliminary Design and Environmental Analysis, Year 6-7: Final Design, Year 8: Right of Way Purchase, Year 9: Utility Relocation, and Year 10: Construction.

BUSINESS: Eunice Holland, Transportation Planner

Mrs. Holland presented a list of new projects for Highway District 11 and Highway District 12 to be approved and added to the UPL. The projects were identified during the development of the District Transportation Plan. Four projects were added for Leslie County in District 11. District 12 added three projects in Knott County and one in Letcher County. Mayor G.C. Kincer made the motion to approve the eight projects. Judge Dennis Brooks seconded the motion. Motion passed. The listing of new projects is attached to the Minutes.
