CALL TO ORDER

The KRADD Regional Transportation Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 11:10 AM by Chairman Mayor Todd DePriest. He welcomed those in attendance and asked that attendees mute their microphones and when making a motion or second to state your name.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mayor Tracy Neice made the motion to approve the Minutes from the August 12, 2020 meeting. The motion was seconded by Mayor Tom Burns. Motion carried. The Minutes are on file in the KRADD office.

GUEST SPEAKER

Mrs. Holland introduced Jacob Huber with KYTC Division of Planning. Jacob discussed the upcoming Rural Consultation Survey. This survey is conducted every 5 years. Postcards and emails will be sent to the Regional Transportation Committee Members in the Commonwealth providing the link to the survey and contact information to request a paper form. There are 25 questions on the survey and it will be open until December 30th. This will give an opportunity to comments and provide suggestions for the Transportation Planning Program at the ADDs.

BUSINESS:

- FY 2021 Committee By-Laws: Chairman Mayor Todd DePriest drafted the following language to include in the By-Laws for the RTC to meet virtually.
At any time, both regular and special meetings may be held virtually via video or other KRADD-approved virtual meeting service where all members can be seen and heard. The necessity of holding a virtual meeting will be decided on by the RTC chairman and care should be taken to ensure all members and public participants have access to these meetings.
Judge Chuck Caudill made the motion to approve the changes to the By-Laws. Mayor Tracy Neice seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- FY 2021 Goals & Objectives: The Committee By-Laws and Goals & Objectives were presented to the Committee for their approval. There are no changes from the previous fiscal year. Mayor Tracy Neice made the motion to approve the Goals & Objectives as presented. The motion was seconded by Jack Burkich. Motion carried.
- SHIFT Prioritization: Prioritization will begin in January with local meetings and the selection of projects to sponsor. BOOST points will be added at the August RTC Meeting. The schedule is subject to change.
- Local Meetings: Mrs. Holland has held all local meetings except Leslie County. Projects were discussed at the meetings.

- Community Change Grants: Applications are due November 9th. The grants are for \$1,500 and can be for promoting bicycling and walking and for murals. Eunice sent the grant information to Mayors and Judges on October 5th.
